Men Building Bridges Program

The Men Building Bridges program will assist men in Victorian bushfire affected areas to reconnect with each other and the community through skills, knowledge building and information based activities to support men's psychological recovery and the community rebuilding process. The program will provide grant funding to conduct workshops that provide opportunities for men to learn new skills and working bees to assist in community recovery and rebuilding after the 2009 Victorian bushfires.
