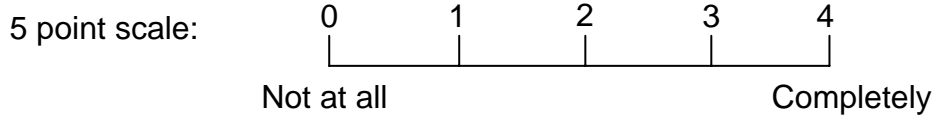


## Medical Staff – PICD Survey
