New home for WGHG Trafalgar Community Health Centre

The West Gippsland Healthcare Group Board of Directors recently sealed its commitment to providing ongoing health services to the people of Trafalgar with the purchase of a permanent home for its community health centre.

The Group has taken ownership of 9 Contingent Street, a location that Chief Executive Officer, Ormond Pearson, says, "Is ideal for people to access when they are out and about doing their shopping or attending appointments."

Building works are currently underway to transform the residential dwelling to meet the requirements of a health centre.

The Group has occupied the RSL hall in Contingent Street which it shares with the Trafalgar Youth Resource Centre for a number of years. Mr Pearson said, "We are extremely grateful to RSL headquarters for their cooperation and support in allowing us to provide health services from this venue."

The Youth Resource Centre will relocate with West Gippsland Healthcare Group to the new premises early in April.
